NATIVE

This is a small deciduous tree native to the eastern United States. It thrives on this land & plays an important role in the ecos

important role in the ecosystem.

UNIQUE

It attracts the black and white stripped Zebra Swallowtail whose caterpillars feed exclusively on Asimina leaves.

FRUIT BEARING

The pawpaw produces fruit that starts ripening from August to September. The fruit can be described as a cross between the banana and the mango because of its vibrant flavors and creamy texture. The fruit has a relatively short shelf life so its best to eat them fast.

TROPICAL

The trees short stature and long broad leaves give it a tropical appearance. This, along with the fruits tropical tasting fruit make it hard to believe that it's native to the eastern United States.

MEDICINAL

The pawpaw has a few medicinal characteristics. If the seeds are crushed into a powder they can be used as a lice repellent when applied to the scalp, the oils from the leaves have cancer fighting properties, and the leaves can externally be applied to the skin to treat sores.

HISTORICAL

The plant was first recorded by the Hernando De Soto expedition in 1540. They noted that the fruit was apart of the native Indian's diets and was a readily available form of nutrition for them while they trekked along the states.
